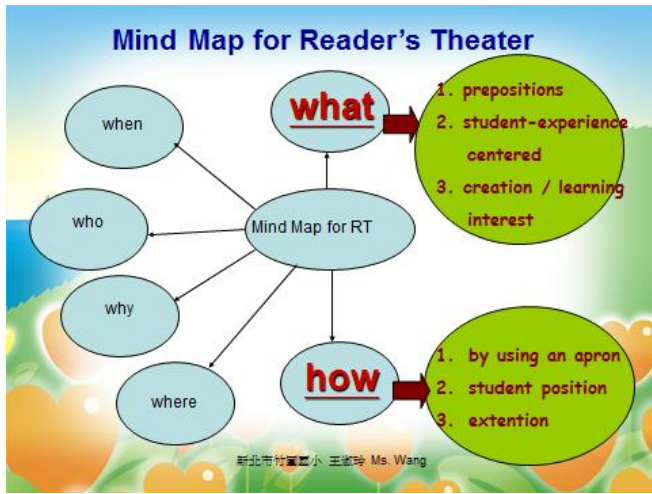


Motivation for Applying Reader's Theater

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Reader Theater's Script for Inspiration
